 - (2) Equipment used to service the building; and
 - (3) Your building materials and supplies used for construction;

provided such property is intended to be permanently located in or on the building or structure described in the Declarations or within 100 feet of its premises;

c. If not covered by other insurance, temporary structures built or assembled on site, including cribbing, scaffolding and construction forms.

2. Property Not Covered

Covered Property does not include:

- a. Land (including land on which the property is located) or water;
- **b.** The following property when outside of buildings:
 - (1) Lawns, trees, shrubs or plants;

- (2) Radio or television antennas (includir satellite dishes) and their lead-in wirin masts or towers; or
- (3) Signs (other than signs attached buildings).

3. Covered Causes Of Loss

4. Additional Coverages

This Coverage Part is void in any case of fraud by you as it relates to this Coverage Part at any time. It is also void if you or any other insured, at any time, intentionally conceal or misrepresent a material fact concerning:

- This Coverage Part;

- 3. Your interest in the Coverd
- A claim under this Coverage Part.

B. CONTROL OF PROPERTY

Any act or neglect of any person other than you beyond your direction or control will not affect this insurance.

The breach of any condition of this Coverage Part at any one or more locations will not affect coverage at any location where, at the time of loss or damage, the breach of condition does not exist.

C. INSURANCE UNDER TWO OR MORE COVER-AGES

If two or more of this policy's coverages apply to the same loss or damage, we will not pay more than the actual amount of the loss or damage.

D. LEGAL ACTION AGAINST US

No one may bring a legal action against us under this Coverage Part unless:

- There has been full compliance with all of the terms of this Coverage Part; and
- 2. The action is brought within 2 years after the date on which the direct physical loss or damage occurred.

E. LIBERALIZATION

If we adopt any revision that would broaden the coverage under this Coverage Part without additional premium within 45 days prior to or during the policy period, the broadened coverage will immediately apply to this Coverage Part.

F. NO BENEFIT TO BAILEE

No person or organization, other than you, having custody of Covered Property will benefit from the insurance.

G. OTHER INSURANCE

- 1. You may have other insurance subject to the same can, terms, conditions and provisions a condition of the coverage Part. If you do very ill the proportion that the applicable Limit of Insurance under this Coverage Part bears to the Limits of Insurance all insurance covering on the same basis.

UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK POLICY

- 1. The insurance does not apply:
 - A. Under any Liability Coverage, to poorly it dry or "property damage":
 (1) With respect to which an "insured" under
 - (1) With respect to which an "insureu" under the policy is also an insured under a nuclear energy liability policy issued by Nuclear Energy Liability Insurance Association, Mutual Atomic Energy Liability Underwriters, Nuclear Insurance Association of Canada or any of their successors, or would be an insured under any such policy but for its termination upon exhaustion of its limit of liability; or
 - (2) Resulting from the "hazardous properties" of "nuclear material" and with respect to which (a) any person or organization is required to maintain financial protection pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, or any law amendatory thereof, or (b) the "insured" is, or had this policy not been issued would be, entitled to indemnity from the United States of America, or any agency thereof, under any agreement entered into by the United States of America, or any agency thereof, with any person or organization.
 - **B.** Under any Medical Payments coverage, to expenses incurred with respect to "bodily injury" resulting from the "hazardous properties" of "nuclear material" and arising out of the operation of a "nuclear facility" by any person or organization.

- C. Under thy Liability Coverage, to "bodily injured to be a substitute of "nuclear material", "he nuclear material" (a) is at any "nuclear facility" owned by, or operated by or on be half of, an "insured" or (b) has been discharged or dispersed therefrom;
 - (2) The "nuclear material" is contained "spent fuel" or "waste" at any time po sessed, handled, used, processed, store transported or disposed of, by or on beha of an "insured"; or
 - (3) The "bodily injury" or "property damag arises out of the furnishing by an "insure of services, materials, parts or equipme in connection with the planning, constrution, maintenance, operation or use of an "nuclear facility", but if such facility is I cated within the United States of Americality territories or possessions or Canada, the exclusion (3) applies only to "proper damage" to such "nuclear facility" and an

"Hazardous properties" includes radioactive, tox or explosive properties.

"Nuclear material" means "source material" Special nuclear material" or "by-product material".

"by-product material" have the meanings given them in the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 or in any law amendatory thereof.

"Spent fuel" means any fuel element or fuel component, solid or liquid, which has been used or exposed to radiation in a "nuclear reactor".

"Waste" means any waste material (a) containing "by-product material" other the trings of wastes produced by the extreme of content action of uranium or thorium from a content action of uranium or thorium from a content action of uranium or thorium from a content action of primarily for its "source material content and (b) resulting from the operation by any person or organization of any "nuclear facility" included under the first two paragraphs of the definition of "nuclear facility".

"Nuclear reactor" means any apparatus designed or used to sustain nuclear fission in a se supporting chain reaction or to contain a critic mass of fissionable material.

"Property damage" includes all forms of radioa tive contamination of property.
